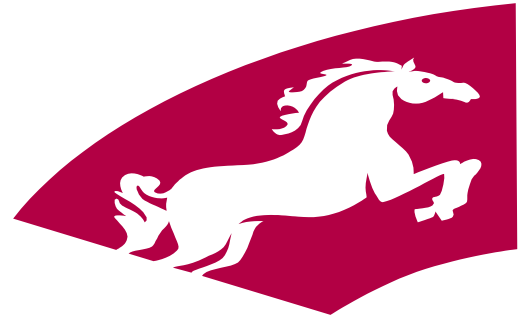

## LANGUAGE ARTS:



- Word Work: -in & -ill families
- Read and spell Fry Sight Words: **am, no, little, it, ran**
- Know & apply grade-level phonics and word analysis in decoding words
- Handwriting -proper letter formation & positioning
- Ask & Answer questions about key details in a text
- Explain major differences between books that tell stories and books that give information
- Read on- level text with fluency and understanding
- Demonstrate understanding of the organization and basic features of print
- Read with sufficient accuracy & fluency to support comprehension

## MATH:



- Base ten numbers
- Count to 120, starting at any number
- Comparing numbers - what comes before or after a number; which number is more (greater) or less
- Putting numerals in order; ordinal numbers
- Organize, represent & interpret data with up to 3 categories; ask and answer questions
- Define attributes of shapes
- Compose 2 dimensional shapes to create a composite shape
- Partition circles and squares into 2 & 4 equal shares
